Covid-19 Testing Policy

All attendees at in-person residency are required to show a negative Covid-19 test taken within 48 hours to enter Hult. Beginning in February 2022, Presidio will provide Covid-19 testing on-site for all students, faculty, and staff. Testing must be repeated every 48 hours.

Event Policy

Following an evaluation of local, state, and federal health guidelines, Presidio Graduate School will allow community events to take place with the following requirements:

Indoor Events

Indoor events are permitted. All attendees are required to submit proof of vaccination and wear a mask throughout the event. We strongly recommend surgical or N95 masks, though cloth masks are permitted. Masks must be worn properly, tightly fitting, and cover the nose and mouth at all times while indoors. Food and drink may not be served or consumed indoors.

Outdoor Events

Outdoor events are permitted. All attendees are required to submit proof of vaccination. Students, staff, and faculty who have already submitted proof of vaccination will not be rechecked. Guests or those who have not yet submitted proof of vaccination will be asked to show their vaccination card. Food and drink may be served and consumed outdoors, and masks are optional.

Effective November 3, 2021

Mask Mandate

In accordance with recommendations from the <u>California Department of Public Health</u> and the <u>Centers for Disease Control</u> and requirements in <u>Alameda County</u>, anyone attending indoor, in-person events at Presidio, regardless of vaccination status, must wear a mask. We strongly recommend surgical or N95 masks, though cloth masks are permitted. Masks must be worn properly, tightly fitting, and cover the nose and mouth at all times while indoors. Individuals who cannot or do not wish to wear a mask or who violate the mask mandate will be asked to attend Residency virtually.

Additional Safety Measures

In addition to the policies and procedures adopted by Presidio to protect the safety of our community and make a positive impact toward controlling the spread of Covid-19, we are also providing the following safety measures:

Daily check-ins at Residency to affirm vaccination and current lack of symptoms

- Temperature checks at check-in for Residency
- Individual social distancing comfort color-coding identification system
- Covid-19 Task Force assigned to regularly review new information and best practices, including advising from Board Member, Dr. Pankaj Bhargava
